

Judge Dan Buckley serves as the Assistant Presiding Judge of the Los Angeles County Superior Court. He previously was the Supervising Judge of Civil and the Supervising Judge of the East District. Judge Buckley has handled a wide range of case types, including misdemeanor, general civil, felony trial, felony master calendar and probate. He is a member of the Judicial Council, has been a member of a number of state-wide and LASC committees, is active in judicial education, and chairs LASC's Technology Committee.

Before taking the bench in 2002, Judge Buckley was a shareholder at the Los Angeles firm of Breidenbach, Buckley, Huchting, Halm & Hamblet. He had a general civil defense practice with a concentration of trials in the areas of toxic torts, professional negligence, personal injury and insurance coverage. He also served as managing partner for a number of years.
